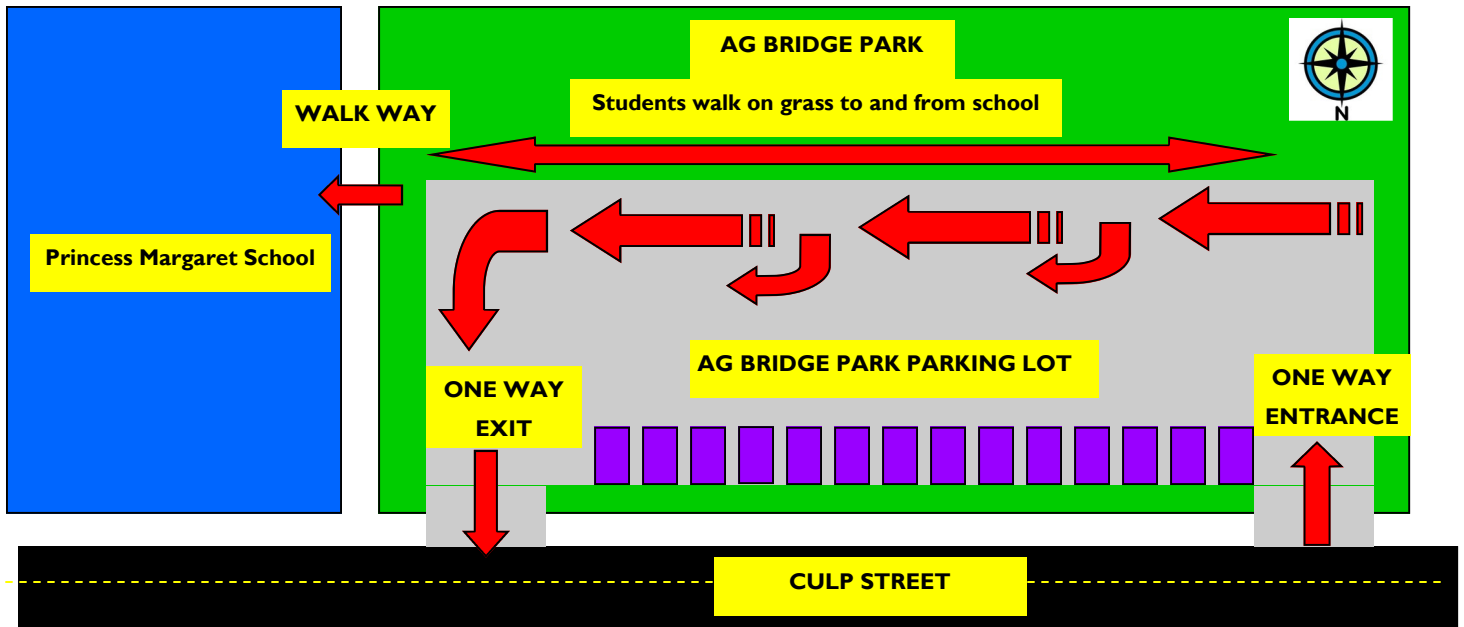


KISS AND RIDE



As we start a new school year, we would like to review the Kiss and Ride rules. The Kiss and Ride occurs in the parking lot of AG Bridge Park to the west of the school.

In 2004, the Parent Council at Princess Margaret School, the District School Board of Niagara and the City of Niagara Falls reached an agreement on the school's use of the parking lot for our Kiss and Ride.

It was hoped that the Kiss and Ride would provide a safe way for students to be dropped off picked up at school and be convenient for parents.

Parents are asked to enter the parking lot by the west en-

trance. It is marked as a one way entrance and exit at the east end of the parking lot by the one way exit.

If you need to park and leave your vehicle we ask that you park on the north side of the parking lot. There is a sign at the southwest end of the parking lot indicating that this area is a no-parking area and designated for the Kiss and Ride.

DROP-OFF

When dropping off your child, in the morning, students can exit the vehicle and walk on the grass to the walkway and onto school property. Students are then asked to proceed around to the back of the school to their designated areas.

PICK-UP

When picking up your student after dismissal, we ask that you line-up along the south side of the park. We ask that you remain in your vehicle. Students should come down the walkway and move along the grass to their vehicle. Students are asked to carefully enter their vehicle. Once the vehicle is loaded the driver can pull out of the line and proceed out, the one way exit, at the east end of the park.

We ask that all of our parents are courteous to all of the other users of the park. From time to time, there are baseball tournaments or other special events at the park and these lead to considerable disruption of the Kiss and Ride area.
